

Stage Hair & Make Up – Preparation

HAIR- ALL dancers' hair should be in a high bun with no bangs or hair in face

Make Up: For our younger students, blush and lipstick will work if full make up is not desired.

1. Apply foundation that matches the skin color of the child's face blending downward into the neck.
2. Apply blush to the apples of cheeks, using a bit more than necessary to the color will show on stage.
3. Apply a purple shade of eye shadow to the upper eyelid.
4. Apply eyeliner lightly on the upper lash line.
5. Pat translucent face powder all over the face to set the make up and get rid of shine.
6. Apply mascara lightly to the eyelashes of the child.
7. Apply a red shade of lipstick to the lips staying within the lip lines.
